<p>How many participants are needed for the Program to proceed?</p>	<p>Twenty participants are needed for the Program to proceed.</p>
<p>Has the Program been run before?</p>	<p>The Program was run in 2023 in Melbourne’s CBD. It was run in 2024 in the Central NSW Region.</p>
